INTRODUCTION

Quark® Print Collection 1.0 includes four software modules that help you transform completed QuarkXPress® 7 projects, QuarkXPress Passport® 7 projects, and Adobe® Acrobat® 7.x PDF files into press-ready output files. Your original QuarkXPress projects and PDF files remain unchanged, but you can add custom press marks and align pages correctly for final cutting and binding (that is, "imposition"). The XTensions® modules in the Quark Print Collection are Quark Imposer™ for QuarkXPress, Quark Imposer for Adobe Acrobat,

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Introduction

Introduction

This ReadMe file covers the four software modules included in Quark Print Collection 1.0. Three of the components — Imposer.xnt, ItemMarks.xnt, and MarkIt.xnt — are XTensions modules for QuarkXPress. The fourth component — Imposer.acroplugin (Mac OS®) and Imposer.api (Windows®) — is a plug-in module for Adobe Acrobat Standard and Adobe Acrobat Professional.

This document explains how to install, register, and validate the software modules. For information about using the modules, see A Guide to Quark Print Collection 1.

Minimum system requirements

This section lists the minimum system requirements for Quark Print Collection 1.0.

Installing Quark Print Collection: Mac OS

To install Quark Print Collection 1.0 on Mac OS:

- 1 Quit QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport and Adobe Acrobat Professional.
- **2** Double-click the "Quark Print Collection" icon. The **Authenticate** dialog box displays.
- **3** Enter your administrator name and password in the appropriate fields, and then click **OK.** The welcome screen displays.



- 4 Click **Continue.** The **Validation Code** dialog box displays.
- To install a fully functional copy of the software using a validation code, click Install Quark Print Collection Full Version, and then enter the validation code provided in the product packaging.
- To install a fully functional copy of the software that expires after 30 days, click **Install Quark Print Collection Evaluation Version.**
- **5** Click **OK.** The License screen of the **Quark Print Collection** dialog box displays.
- **6** Read the license agreement carefully, and then click **Continue**.
- 7 If you accept the terms of the agreement, click **Agree.** If you do not accept the terms, click **Disagree.**

NOTE You must accept the terms of the license agreement to continue.

- 8 The Installation Type screen displays. Choose one of the following options from the drop-down menu:
- Choose **Complete Install** to install all of the program files. This option requires the most disk space.
- Choose Custom Install to install only the items you select. Click the disclosure triangles to view individual installable items. Click an item's icon to see a description of the item. All items are checked by default; uncheck any items you do not want to install.
- **9** Click **Install.** A progress bar indicates the progress of the installation.

NOTE If you are running multiple copies of QuarkXPress, QuarkXPress Passport, or Adobe Acrobat, select the application you are installing the Quark Print Collection for, then click **OK**.

10 Click **Quit** when the installer notifies you installation is complete.

Adding files after installation

To add files after installation, follow the instructions in "Installing Quark Print Collection: Mac OS." Use the **Custom Install** option to select the items you want to install.

Installing Quark Print Collection: Windows

To install Quark Print Collection on Windows:

- 1 Quit QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport and Adobe Acrobat Professional.
- 2 Double-click the "setup.exe" icon. The Quark Print Collection Setup dialog box displays.
- 3 Click Next. The License Agreement screen displays.
- 4 Read the license agreement carefully. If you accept the terms of the agreement, click I accept the terms in the license agreement. If you do not accept the terms, click I do not accept the terms in the license agreement.

NOTE You must accept the terms of the license agreement to continue.



- 5 Click Next. The Software Verification screen displays.
- To install a fully functional copy of the software using a validation code, click Install Quark Print Collection Full Version, and then enter the validation code provided in the product packaging.
- To install a fully functional copy of the software that expires after 30 days, click **Install Quark Print Collection Evaluation Version.**
- 6 Click Next. The Setup Type screen displays.
- Click **Complete** to install all of the Quark Print Collection 1.0 files.
- Click Custom and then click Next to install only the files you select.
- 7 If you click **Custom** and then click **Next**, the **Custom Setup** dialog box displays. Click the disclosure boxes to see individual installable items. Click an item to see its description in the **Feature Description** area. Click the drop-down menu next to each item name and choose an option:
- This feature will be installed on local hard drive.
- This feature, and all subfeatures, will be installed on local hard drive.
- This feature will not be available.
- 8 Click Next. The Ready to Install the Program screen displays.
- **9** Click **Install.** A progress bar indicates the progress of the installation.
- **10** Click **Finish** when the installer notifies you that installation is complete.

Adding, removing, and repairing files after installation

To add, remove, or repair files after installation:

- **1** Disable any virus protection software.
- 2 Double-click the "setup.exe" icon. The Quark Print Collection Setup dialog box displays.
- 3 Click Next. The Program Maintenance screen displays.
- Click **Modify** to install additional components.
- Click Repair to correct minor problems related to Quark Print Collection 1.0 files. Use this option if you experience issues with missing or damaged Quark Print Collection 1.0 files.
- Click **Remove** to delete the Quark Print Collection 1.0 files. You can run the installer again to install new files.
- 4 Click **Next**, then make the appropriate modifications:
- If you clicked Modify in the Program Maintenance screen, the Custom Setup screen displays. Choose additional items to install, click Next, and then click Install.
- If you clicked Repair in the Program Maintenance screen, the Ready to Repair the Program screen displays. Click Install.
- If you clicked Remove in the Program Maintenance screen, the Remove the Program screen displays. Click Remove.
- **5** Click **Finish** when the process is complete.



Registering Quark Print Collection

You can register Quark Print Collection online during or after installation.

Performing online registration during installation

If you click Yes to register during installation, you are directed to the "Online registration" page of the Quark Web site. Review the information in the form and enter the required data. When you are finished, the Web browser submits the information to Quark. Once your information has been received by Quark, the Web browser displays a window stating that registration was successful. You can then exit the Web browser.

NOTE If the installer is unable to locate a Web browser or process your registration, the installation is completed without registering your software. To register your software, follow the instructions in "Performing online registration after installation."

NOTE It may take as many as three days for Quark to process your online registration. However, Quark Print Collection will run with full functionality in evaluation mode for thirty days, so you do not have to wait for registration to begin using the software.

Performing online registration after installation

The installer creates a folder called "Registration Folder" in the QuarkXPress application folder. The "Register.htm" file in this folder lets you register using any computer that has Internet access and a compatible Web browser (see "Minimum system requirements").

- 1 Double-click the "Register.htm" file to launch the Web browser and open the file. Alternatively, you can use the **File** menu in your Web browser to open the "Register.htm" file.
- **2** Review the information in the form, make any necessary changes, and then click **Submit.** The Web browser submits the information to Quark.
- 3 Once your information has been received by Quark, the Web browser displays a window stating that registration was successful. You can then exit the Web browser.

NOTE You can also register by phone. See "Contacting Quark" for contact information.

NOTE It may take as many as three days for Quark to process your online registration. However, Quark Print Collection will run with full functionality in evaluation mode for thirty days, so you do not have to wait for registration to begin using the software.

Uninstalling Quark Print Collection Mac OS

Quark Print Collection 1.0 includes three XTensions modules for QuarkXPress and a plug-in for Adobe Acrobat Professional. You can remove any or all of these files by dragging them to the trash.

NOTE Before you uninstall, quit QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport and Adobe Acrobat.

 To remove the XTensions modules: Open the "XTensions" folder in your QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport folder and drag the Quark Print Collection 1.0 files to the trash. (The names of the files are Imposer.xnt, ItemMarks.xnt, and MarkIt.xnt.)



 To remove the Adobe Acrobat plug-in: Control+click the Adobe Acrobat 7 application icon and choose Show Package Contents. In the window that displays, open the "Plug-ins" folder and then drag the file named "Imposer.acroplugin" to the trash.

Windows

To uninstall Quark Print Collection 1.0 on Windows, complete the following steps:

- 1 Quit QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport and Adobe Acrobat.
- 2 Choose Start → Control Panel → Add or Remove Programs. The Add or Remove Programs dialog box displays.
- 3 Select Quark Print Collection 1.0 and click Remove.

NOTE You can also run the Quark Print Collection installer again to remove your Quark Print Collection files.

Last-minute changes

Support for 6-up imposition

Quark Imposer for QuarkXPress and Quark Imposer for Adobe Acrobat now also support basic 6-up imposition.

NOTE 6-up imposition is intended for a specific workflow and does not include all of the features that are available in the other imposition layouts.

Managing styles

To add a new style in the **Imposer** dialog box, choose **Add Style** from the **Style** drop-down menu. To update the selected style with

any changes you have made to settings in the **Imposer** dialog box, choose **Update Style** from the **Style** drop-down menu. To rename or delete styles in the **Imposer** dialog box, choose **Manage Styles** from the **Style** drop-down menu.

Sample styles

Quark Print Collection comes with several sample imposition styles. To view and use these styles, import them from the **Imposer** dialog box (**Style** drop-down menu \rightarrow **Manage Styles** \rightarrow **Append** button).
